

House Rules

Safety:

- Keep entrance and exit doors closed at all times.
- Ensure floors are clear of items that may cause slipping hazards.
- Immediately clean and mark wet floors if anything spills.
- Sign in and out of the property in case of emergencies; yard exceptions apply.

General:

- Turn off lights when not in use.
- Do not open cabinets, closets, or windows with locks without prior approval.
- Respect privacy; do not enter other guests' rooms.
- Keep your room door closed and wear clothes outside of your room.
- Obtain permission before using someone else's items.
- Do not leave personal items unattended in common areas.
- Licensees allowed entry is between 6AM and 10PM; exceptions require notice.
- Licensees needing syringe disposal must use a medical-grade bin.
- Adhere to medication schedules as prescribed by your physician.
- Licensees are required to limit shower times to a maximum of 15 minutes to conserve water and ensure fair usage for all residents.

Kitchen Use:

- Wash and dry dishes and cookware after use to maintain kitchen cleanliness.

Smoking, Alcohol, and Drugs:

- Smoke only in designated areas; no smoking inside or near doors.
- No alcohol consumption or storage on premises.
- Do not share medication.
- No illegal drugs or unprescribed medication allowed.

Visitors:

- Visitors allowed in living room, kitchen, and bathroom **only**.
- Visiting hours are between 10:00AM-8:00PM.
- Visitors, including Care Providers, must sign in and out.
- Guests are responsible for their visitors' behavior; limit of 2 guests indoors at once.

Cleanliness:

- Dispose of trash properly, place dirty dishes in the sink, and clean up after bathroom use.
- Maintain orderly and sanitary conditions in your room.

- Food is prohibited in bedrooms to prevent attracting insects such as roaches and to maintain cleanliness and hygiene throughout the living space.
- Clean up spills or messes promptly.

Your Room:

- Never remove mattress covers.
- Do not enter any bedroom other than your own.
- Keep room door closed; secure valuable items.

Personal Hygiene:

- Dispose of diapers, bed pads, and personal hygiene items properly.
- Maintain personal hygiene with regular bathing and tooth brushing.
- You shall have no complaints that you or your personal space has offensive odors.

Behavior:

- No profanity or offensive language toward residents, other licensees, or staff.
- **No aggressive or violent behavior. EVER!**
- No lending or borrowing money among residents.

Laundry:

- Use laundry facilities only on scheduled days.
- Do not wash another person's clothes.
- You may not put feces soiled items into any washer or dryer in the home or the laundry.
